

DANCE GUIDELINES
South O'Brien High School

Extra-curricular activities, including the attending of a dance, are a privilege not a right. Any privilege also has higher expectations that go with participation in the activity.

PROCEDURAL ITEMS:

1. The principal must approve school-sponsored dances at least two weeks prior to the dance.
2. If a student leaves, they leave for the night and will not be readmitted.
3. The doors will close a half hour after the start of the dance.
4. There will be an officer on duty.
5. There will be a breathalyzer on hand for each of the dance.
6. If a student has been drinking, a call will be place to the parents to come get their child.
7. Students of the sponsoring organization are responsible for getting chaperones. There needs to be in minimum of 6 chaperones.
8. Outside dates must be registered ahead of time in the high school office. Anyone bringing an outside date without registering them will not be allowed to enter.
9. The group sponsoring the dance will be responsible for set up and clean up.
10. Entry to and dismissal from the dance will occur through one entrance.

BEHAVIORAL EXPECTATIONS:

1. Treat each other with dignity and respect.
2. In general, the school day's dress code will be followed.
3. No grinding or inappropriate contact.
4. If there is a problem with dress, the student must change into appropriate clothes prior to returning to the dance.
5. Behavior problems—minors will receive a warning and then removal if it continues; major will result in immediate removal.
6. Students with restricted driver's licenses will be responsible for completing the necessary form.
