

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING AND LETTING
for
2018 South O'Brien Community School District Track Improvements
Project

Public notice is hereby given that the School Board of the South O'Brien Community School District, in O'Brien County, Iowa, will meet on Thursday, March 15, 2018, at 6:30 P.M., at which time and place a hearing will be held in the conference board room located at 216 South Rutledge Street, Paullina, IA 51046 on the proposed plans and specifications, form of contract and estimate of cost for the 2018 South O'Brien Community School District Track Improvements Project for said school district. Sealed proposals will be received by the Superintendent of the South O'Brien Community School District for the 2018 South O'Brien Community School District Track Improvements Project until 2:00 P.M. on Tuesday, March 13, 2018, at the District Office, located at 216 South Rutledge Street, Paullina, IA 51046; at which time the bids will be publicly opened and read. Proposals will be acted on by the South O'Brien School Board at the aforementioned public hearing or at such later time and place as may then be fixed.

Work to Be Done:

Base Bid generally consists of: approximately 29 Units of Clearing and Grubbing; 1065 CY of Topsoil, On-Site; 135 CY of Topsoil, Off-Site; 454 CY of Excavation, Class 10; 4,735 SY of Subgrade Preparation, 12"; 901 SY of 2" Modified Subbase; 4,867 SY of 6" Modified Subbase; 1,102 L.F. of Storm Sewer, Trenched; 1,475 LF of 6" HDPE Subdrain; 20 Each Subdrain Outlets and Connections; 10 Each Storm Sewer Intakes; 101 SY of 6" PCC Pavement; 4,574 SY of 2.5" HMA Base Course Pavement; 4,414 SY of 1.5" HMA Surface Course Pavement; 1 LS HMA Pavement Samples and Testing; 893 SY of PCC Sidewalk;; 1 LS of Temporary Traffic Control; 1.6 Acres of Conventional Seeding, Seeding, Fertilizing and Hydro-Mulching; 86 SQ Sod; 1 LS Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan, Management; 850 LF of Silt Fence, Installation and Removal; 120 SY of Stabilized Construction Entrance; 13 Each Inlet Protection Device, Installation and Maintenance; 1,448 L.F. of Black Coated Chain Link Fence; 6 Each Fence Gates; 1 LS Mobilization; 4,414 SY of ½" Resilient Surfacing, Polyurethane Track Surface; 1 LS Striping; 1 Each Long Jump Pit and Runway; 105 L.F. of Aco Sport Trench Drain System; 1 Each Shot Put and other related items of work.

Proposals: All proposals shall be made on official proposal forms furnished by the Engineer and shall contain worded and figured prices for the work bid on. All proposals shall be plainly legible, sealed, and addressed to the South O'Brien Community Schools, Attn: Dan Moore, Superintendent, South O'Brien Community School District, 216 South Rutledge Street, Paullina, IA 51046. Bidder shall submit a Bidder Status Form with their bid. Failure to submit a fully completed Bidder Status Form with the bid may result in the bid being deemed unresponsive and rejected. A certified check or a bid bond of a reputable bonding company authorized to do business in the State of Iowa in an amount not less than ten percent (10%) of the total amount of the bid shall be included in a separate sealed envelope, plainly marked "bid bond". The bid guarantee shall be forfeited as liquidated damages if the successful bidder fails proper execution.

The checks or bid bonds of the lowest two or more bidders may be held for the earlier of 7 days after the effective date of the agreement or 61 days after the bid opening, whereupon Bid Security furnished by such bidders will be returned. Other checks or bid bonds will be returned after the tabulation of bids is completed.

Performance and Payment Bonds: The successful bidder must execute performance and payment bonds, each in an amount equal to one hundred (100%) percent of the contract amount to ensure a timely, efficient, and complete performance. The bonds shall be issued from a reputable bonding company authorized to do business in the State of Iowa.

Liquidated Damages: Liquidated damages will be assessed the contractor in the amount of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) per working day that the work remains uncompleted after the end of the contract period with due allowances for extensions due to conditions beyond the control of the contractor.

Withdrawal of Bids: No submitted bids may be withdrawn for a period of thirty (30) days from the scheduled closing time for the receipt of bids.

Payment: The Contractor will be paid monthly in an amount equal to ninety-five percent (95%) of the Work completed during the previous month according to the Engineer's estimate. The final payment will be made not less than thirty (30) days after completion of the Work and acceptance by the School. No final payment will be due until the Contractor has certified that the materials, labor, and services have been paid for in accordance with the Project Manual.

A refundable deposit of \$100.00 is required for the documents. Deposit will be returned if plans and project manual are returned in good condition within 14 days after public hearing date.

Acceptance or Rejection of Bids: The right to accept or reject any or all bids and to waive informalities is reserved.

Time Frame:

All work shall be completed by August 17, 2018

By virtue of statutory authority, preference will be given to products and provisions grown and coal produced within the State of Iowa and to Iowa domestic labor to the extent lawfully required under Iowa statutes, providing that the award of the contract will be made to the lowest responsible bidder submitting the lowest acceptable bid, which shall be given without regard to state or local law whereby preference is given on factors other than the amount of the bid.
