Among the most important advances in student discipline programs over the past years is the recognition of the need for school-wide behavior support systems. Historically, discipline in schools has been driven by attention to specific children with problem behaviors.

The goal of the school-wide system is to define, teach, and support appropriate behaviors in a way that establishes a culture of competence within schools. Once this culture is established, the students are more likely to support appropriate behavior and discourage inappropriate behavior by their peers.
